

GTU is the only Indian University selected by European Union (EU) under Erasmus+ Funded Program

Gujarat Technological University has received very prestigious grant from



European Union i.e. Erasmus+ **(European Region Action Scheme for the Mobility of University Students/Staff)** for staff mobility with Wroclaw University of Science and Technology, Wroclaw, Poland. European Union has started this

program in 1987. GTU has received invitation from Wroclaw University to participate in the International Staff Week under Erasmus+ program for four participants. Erasmus+ is the European Union programme for education, training, youth and sport. It runs for seven years, from 2014 to 2020, with organizations invited to apply for funding each year to undertake creative and worthwhile activities. Erasmus+ aims to modernize education, training and youth work across Europe.

Under the dynamic leadership of Honorable Vice Chancellor, Prof. (Dr.) Navin Sheth, GTU delegation visited Wroclaw University. The delegation also includes Dr. J C Lilani, Dy. Registrar and i/c COE, Dr. Kaushal Bhatt, Assistant



Professor, CGBS and Mr. Amit Patel, Assistant Professor, IPR visited Wroclaw

University for five days. There were 32 participants from 15 countries (Albania, Czech Republic, France, Germany, Italy, Kosova, Lebanon, Portugal, etc.) have participated in the Program and GTU was the only University from India. The participation from GTU was fully funded by Wroclaw University under Erasmus+ Program.

On the first day Dr. Andrzej Moczko, Director International Office, Wroclaw University welcomed all participants. He showed his willingness to initiate new programs i.e. Student Exchange, Staff Exchange, Joint Research Projects in association with GTU. The staff members of International office and other participants were highly impressed by the activities carried out by GTU.



During the visit of Poland, GTU has signed MoU with Warsaw University of Technology. The Warsaw University of Technology is the Public University of Poland and it was established in the year 1915. The Mou was signed in the presence of Prof. (Dr.) Rajmund Bacewicz, Vice Rector for Research, H.E. Amarjeet Singh Takhi, Counsellor, Embassy of India, Warsaw, Poland and Mr. Ashok Mannani, President as well as Mr. Maharshi Shah, Vice President, India International Foundation, Poland.



The visit was highly successful and it is assumed that the students of GTU will get direct benefit of this international cooperation.
