The meeting commenced with the introduction of the officials and exchange of visiting cards.

MR KEYUR DARJI – DEPUTY DIRECTOR, CENTRE FOR GLOBAL BUSINESS STUDIES - GTU

Mr Keyur Darji – Deputy Director, Centre for global business studies brief about the Gujarat Technological University its role in the affiliating kind of a structure and also explained how the setup of GTU is different than that of universities in Europe.

He stated that GTU was keen to start the exchange program under Erasmus+ and discussed the issues related to the timing, Number of mobility, Subject mapping for the same.

Mr Darji also explained about how GTU conducts International Experience Program (IEP) with its other university partners and would also like to explore the opportunity for the same with Wroclaw University.

DR RAJUL GAJJAR - HON'BLE VICE CHANCELLOR - GTU

Dr Rajul Gajjar - Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, GTU was keen to explore the opportunity of ERASMUS + and showed interest in executing the same. She proposed an innovative opportunity for students from Wroclaw University to come to GTU for an internship where students can be given live exposure by involving them in the Government projects in Gujarat. This could be a new opportunity for them to work in India as an intern and also, this may increase the opportunity for them regarding employability in home country.

Dr Gajar also shared the opportunity to invite the faculties of Wroclaw to associate with GTU as Co Supervisors in GTU Ph.D program.

PROPOSAL FROM WROCLAW OFFICIALS

Wroclaw officials discussed in detail about the funded program with reference to the commitment of No. of mobility, learning agreement, their limitations regarding the subject mapping and suggested probable solution to the issues addressed for ERASMUS+

They were interested in exploring the opportunity of student's internship at Gujarat. Co Supervisors options seemed to be quite feasible for implementation from their part and were keen to have more details regarding the same.

After an exhaustive discussion about the stated agendas the meeting ended with vote of thanks.
